Subject: The Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991--reg.

Sir,

You are aware that an industry is required to subscribe an insurance policy under the Public Liability Insurance (PLI) Act, 1991 provided the industry / facility is handling hazardous substance(s) beyond prescribed threshold limits as listed under the PLI Act. Along with the insurance premium, industry must make a contribution equal to insurance premium paid to 'Environment Relief Fund (ERF)', established by the Central Government. All petroleum oil refineries, petro-chemical plants, acid manufacturing units, chemical fertilizer plants, thermal power plants, distilleries, petroleum product depots, sewage treatment plants with sludge digesters, water treatment plants, organic chemical plants, basic pharmaceutical plants, steel plants, LPG bottling plants and natural gas processing plants etc. are required to subscribe to the insurance policy under the PLI Act.

It is requested that the provisions of PLI Act may be implemented effectively.
